

# Supplied Ynglings for Match Racing

## Background

The Women Keelboat Event for the 2012 Olympics will be sailed in Match Race format. The IYA is the suitable organisation to assist Olympic Classes regatta organisers with supplying Ynglings for Match Racing.

## Objective

That the International Yngling Association together with Yngling builders and suppliers set up a non profit organisation that can supply Ynglings for Match Racing to major event organisers such as ISAF and grade 1-2. This organisation will handle everything with aspect to the boats like transports, setting up for regattas, service during regattas and off season.

## Finances

The main costs for this venture will be purchase and service of boats, transports and human resources. The income will be pre selling of boats, rental fees and contributions from the private and commercial sectors.

## Schedule

Before and during the 2008 ISAF mid-year meeting the needs and demands of all stake holders shall be investigated. The main stake holders are; Regatta organisers, Yngling builders, other equipment suppliers, ISAF and IYA.

By the ISAF November conference all agreements shall be in place and ready to go immediately after a positive decision. In the beginning of 2009 Ynglings will be ready for Match Racing.

## The IYA

The Yngling has been an International Class since 1979 and Olympic since 2001. Around 3500 Ynglings exists world wide. About 800 boats are paying membership fees and are raced actively. The International Yngling Association have national organisations in 14 countries on 3 Continents. There are currently 6 licensed builders in Australia, Europe and North America.
